1.	<p>Expatriate with an ACTIVE PASS who is currently in MALAYSIA, which desires to leave the country and to return</p> <p>a) Employment Pass Category (EP I, II & III) & Residence Pass-Talent (RP-T)</p> <p>b) Professional Visit Pass (PVP)</p> <p>c) Dependants & Foreign Maids for EP I, EP II & RP-T</p> <p>d) Long Term Social Visit Pass (LT-SVP) for EP I, EP II & RP-T</p>	<p>i. The applicant is required to obtain Permission to Exit Malaysia and Return from Expatriate Services Division (ESD)</p> <p>ii. The applicant has to submit for the Permission to Exit and Return to Malaysia via email to taskforce_esd@imi.gov.my</p> <p>iii. Upon receiving the Permission to Exit and Return Letter from Expatriate Services Division (ESD), the applicant is to provide the Letter at the entry point upon departure and entering Malaysia.</p> <p>iv. The applicant is allowed to exit Malaysia and MUST return within SIXTY (60) days from the issuance date of the letter.</p> <p>v. The applicant who wish to return Malaysia is REQUIRED to undergo PCR Covid-19 Test abroad within THREE (3) days, and must be medically confirmed to be tested negative for Covid-19 prior to entering Malaysia.</p> <p>vi. It is also COMPULSORY for the expatriate to DOWNLOAD AND INSTALL the “MySejahtera” mobile application before departure. The “MySejahtera” application enables the Ministry of Health (MOH) to monitor users’ health conditions, and for them</p>

		<p>to be able to take immediate actions in providing the treatments required.</p> <p>vii. The applicant MUST undergo a FOURTEEN (14) day SELF-QUARANTINE.</p> <p>viii. The applicant will be required to undergo another PCR Covid-19 Test by the Ministry of Health (MOH). The cost of PCR Covid-19 Test shall be borne by the applicant.</p> <p>ix. The applicant is required to comply with the rules and regulations set by the Immigration Department of Malaysia.</p> <p>x. Permitted Malaysia Entry Points:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) b. Immigration Checkpoint, Sultan Iskandar Building (BSI), Johor c. Sultan Abu Bakar Complex (2nd Link), Johor
2.	<p>Expatriate / PVP / RP-T / Dependents / LT-SVP / foreign maids who is currently in MALAYSIA, and wish to leave the country for good e.g: contract ending / expiring in Malaysia / Pass has been shortened</p>	<p>i. Exempted to obtain Permission to Exit Malaysia from Expatriate Services Division (ESD).</p>
